New directions for the institute and new director

The institute

After having operated as a postdoc institute for over 12 years, EURANDOM is now transforming into a workshop center, building on its strong expertise and reputation in its workshop and visitor programs. Its main aim has been accomplished: forming an internationally renowned research institute in stochastics with substantial critical mass.

In the new set-up we expect to organize around eight workshops per year in the different areas of stochastics. We continue the series of workshops organized for and by young researchers (Young European Stochastic Professionals -YESP). We also intend to have 4 thematic months per year: SAM (Stochastic Activity Month). During a theme month, there will typically be a workshop, but the foremost aim is to bring together a critical mass of researchers from inside and outside The Netherlands. There will be 3-5 lectures per week, and substantial time is devoted to collaboration. At least once a year, such a thematic month should be devoted to a multidisciplinary topic.



Funding for EURANDOM as a postdoc institute has ended. A major change in the Dutch stochastics landscape is the creation of the cluster STAR in

2009. EURANDOM plays a key role in coordinating and initiating activities within STAR.



The position of The Netherlands in the international stochastics community has become stronger in the past 12 years, and the workshops and visitor programmes of EURANDOM have attracted many leading researchers to The Netherlands.

The proven concepts of the EURANDOM workshop programme and the reputation and goodwill earned by the institute offer an excellent opportunity to transform EURANDOM into an international workshop center, and thus to further enhance the position of Dutch stochastics.

From 2012 on, EURANDOM will be located in the new building of the Department of Mathematics and Computer Science (M&CS) of TU/e, sharing a floor with the stochastics section of that Department. This will enhance the strong interaction with the chairs of Borst, Boxma, Van der Hofstad and Van Zanten at M&CS.
