STAR

On December 10, 2009 NWO decided to fund the new mathematics cluster in stochastics, STAR, with an amount of 1,5 million euro for two years (2010 & 2011). From this money mainly positions (postdocs, PhD students and assistant professors) will be sponsored. A part will be used for workshops, a visitor program, outreach, etc. With this grant NWO supports the mathematics cluster STAR, 'Stochastics - Theoretical and Applied Research', that was founded on May 15, 2009 as fourth mathematics cluster. The other clusters were created five years ago to compensate the reducing number of students and staff at academic math-departments. The stochastics cluster STAR got funding to bridge the period from January 2010 to 2012, the year in which decisions about continuation of the clusters are expected to be taken.

100th workshop at EURANDOM



On December 15, we celebrated the fact that EURANDOM organised the 100th workshop at the institute.

The first workshop took place on November 14, 1998, one and a half year after the formal start of the institute. On December 14, 2009 the workshop "Dynamic Random Environments" started, which, was the 100th. The title of the workshop was very appropriate, and refers unintentionally to the cha-*****

racter of the institute. Over 4000 participants, from all over the world visited over 1700 lectures, spread over 318 workshop days.



Board and Scientific Council

The board met in June and December. The way to secure funding for the future and the relations between STAR and EURANDOM were of course among the major points on the agenda.

The Scientific Council met on December 14, 2009. For 3 new members it was their first meeting. We discussed the current and future funding of the institute as well as the relation with the newly funded cluster.

In July 4 members stepped back: Sören Asmussen, Freddy Delbaen, Peter Hall and Andreas Greven. EURANDOM is grateful for their contributions in the past 6 years.
