General News

The second half of 2007 has been a very busy period for EURANDOM.

First of all there was the 14th APS INFORMS Conference in July. In autumn 2007 the Young European Queueing Theorists (YEQT) workshop and Young European Statisticians (YES) workshop took place as a follow-up of the very successful Young European Probabilists (YEP) workshops. The latter is going to organize its 5th workshop in spring 2008. This series of workshops is especially organized by and for young researchers, including tutorials from more senior scientists.

An important activity in the autumn had to do with securing the continuity of the institute.

As, after 10 years, basic funding by NWO and by the board of TU/e is ending at the end of the year, new plans had to be made.

Fortunately, the board of TU/e and the Department of Mathematics and Computer Science have agreed to jointly support the institute (financially and in kind).

For this a change in the formal organization was necessary, and starting January 1, 2008 the institute will be embedded in the Department of Mathematics and Computer Science.

We expect to maintain the workshop- and visitor programmes at the present level of activity.

The number of junior researchers might be reduced slightly if ongoing attempts for additional external funding (e.g. a proposal for a national stochastic cluster, centered

We expect that the changes mentioned above will not affect our present postdocs and PhD students, and we are confident that EURANDOM will be able to maintain its impact and visibility.

Regarding housing: when the Department of Mathematics and Computer Science moves into a new building, EURANDOM will move into that same building.

In the next few years though, we continue to be located in Laplace Building.

Since September 2007 the QPA-programme has a new Senior Fellow: Professor Bas Werker from University of Tilburg, Department of Mathematical Finance.

Bas Werker is professor of Finance and Econometrics at Tilburg University. His research interests cover various fields in asset pricing and asymptotic statistics. He has published work in journals like the Annals of Statistics, the Journal of Econometrics, and the Journal of Finance.
