## General News

Last week the 14<sup>th</sup> APS-INFORMS conference took place. We are proud that we hosted around 360 scientists, young and old, from the US and Canada to Asia and Australia on the premises of Eindhoven University of Technology, where also EURANDOM is located. Keynote speakers were Peter Glynn, Frank Kelly and Alain-Sol Sznitman.

With nine parallel sessions, and - very well attended - tutorials during the lunch break, the conference programme was quite dense. ## Scientific Advisors

The trustees of the Rollo Davidson Trust have decided to award the 2007 Rollo Davidson Prize to Remco van der Hofstad (RSS-advisor) "for his work in probability and statistical mechanics". The Rollo Davidson Trust was founded in 1975 in memory of Rollo Davidson, an accomplished mathematician of remarkable potential, and Fellow-elect of Churchill College (Cambridge), who died on the Piz Bernina in 1970. The Trustees award an annual Prize for young probabilists.

Februari 2, 2007, Michel Mandjes (QPA-advisor) gave his inaugural lecture at the University of Amsterdam. Title of his lecture: 'Nieuwe kansen' (New chances). May 10, 2007 Richard Boucherie (QPA-advisor) gave his inaugural lecture at the University of Twente. Title of his lecture: 'Het antwoord of de vraag' (The answer or the question).

Since May 2007 the QPA-programme has two new Scientific Advisors; Nico Dellaert and Gert-Jan van Houtum, both from the TU/e, Department of Technology Management. They were appointed in the framework of an agreement between the Department of Technology Management and EURANDOM; four PhD students of that department will also spend part of their time in EURANDOM (see 'New people in 2007' on the following page).
