



Seminar description and speaker guidelines:

Goal:

The STO seminar is a platform allowing the stochastics group to invite excellent speakers able to communicate to a broad audience interesting topics with connections to all realms of stochastics (i.e., probability theory/statistics/stochastic operations research) and algorithmics (especially the connection between stochastics & algorithmics). The talks are semina in nature and the emphasis is placed on the context, the motivation, and the main ideas behind the presented results.

Target audience:

Researchers in all areas of stochastics, ranging from first year Ph.D. students to senior researchers. Speakers should assume that the audience solely has basic knowledge of probability theory, statistics, stochastic processes and algorithmics, and a reasonable level of mathematical maturity. Talk format: there are 45 minutes allocated to the talk and 15 minutes to questions.

Location:

The talks take place at the Metaforum building at TU/e (room MF 11/12, 4th floor).

Immediately after the talk there is an informal gathering with drinks and snacks, typically triggering further discussions.
